

The Triumphant Lamb of God!

The Lamb of God, and the eternal glory of God, are compactly related as introduced to the Person of the Lord Jesus Christ in John 1:14: “*And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father) full of grace and truth.*”

“The Revelation of Jesus Christ” opens with the prophetic scenario of our glorified risen, triumphant ‘Lamb of God’, standing in the midst of the ‘Golden Candlesticks’ which represent the light of the Church age from Pentecost to her Rapture ‘in the air’: *“In the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain”* Revelation 5:6. Could it be that a vivid reminder of our suffering Lamb of God will impel us to fall down in overwhelming adoration and praise before His Throne? Because, *“all we like sheep have gone astray ... and the Lord hath laid on Him the iniquity of us all ... He is brought as a Lamb to the slaughter ... He was wounded for our transgressions ... and with His stripes we are healed”* Isaiah 53:5-7.

The Book of Revelation then goes on to describe God’s unsparing wrath that will be poured out on this Christ-rejecting world in which Satan seeks to blasphemously rule as very ‘God.’ The culmination of these seven years of ‘Great Tribulation’ will be when the Triumphant Lamb returns with His ‘Bride’ in His Second Coming to Jerusalem! Presently, prophetic dark clouds of ominous judgement are rapidly unfolding: Persecution of believers has increased and satanic deception abounds. In Christ, we have *“good hope through grace”* soon to be *“caught up together to meet the Lord in the air!”*
