Have you ever been in need? I mean not in want – but truly in need? So much of what we think is need...is really want. But, if you are living in a third world country, you will understand what real need is, AND you will find that God is faithful to SUPPLY all your needs according to His riches in Glory.

Welcome to Grace Notes. Our hosts, Barbara and Dale Sandbek learned to look for God's hand to provide their daily needs as they prepared to build the first Christian Radio station in southern Belize. It's been said that God is the only One who can work good out of bad. Those of us who choose to believe this, find it to be true. Also true, is that when we decide to follow Christ and serve Him, we will encounter adversity, because we live in a world that caters to sin and rejects holy living. Even Jesus, when he was ministering on earth, was constantly under attack. But with all the disruptions, He still accomplished His task to provide eternal salvation for all who believe—and that's not only good—that's GREAT. God will provide what we need to be ambassadors for Christ. On our broadcast today, our host, Barbara Sandbek, will show us how God worked good out of some tough situations that arose when she and her husband, Dale, first arrived in southern Belize, where they planned to build the first Christian radio station. But first, let's listen to a song that gives good advice for handling any struggle we come up against.

***** PRAISE THE LORD *****

Yes, that's good advice. Put on the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness. A lady I know said she played that song for her six-year-old son and he memorized all the words. His favorite line was..."Now Satan...he's a liar!". That's so true. In fact he's the father of lies. I figured if this little boy can remember this throughout his life, he'll never

~~succumb to satan's attacks. 1 Peter 5:8 says that the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour, but verse 9 says that we can resist him by standing firm in the faith.~~

~~In the story of Nehemiah, we find that Nehemiah met with adversity almost immediately after he made his plans known. Two governors of the surrounding regions were very much disturbed that someone had come to promote the welfare of the Israelites and they spent a great deal of time trying to thwart his efforts. But this didn't stop him from plowing forward—he had a job to do and he knew God was with him. I love how 1 Corinthians 1:25 puts it...~~

~~—The foolishness of God is wiser than man's wisdom and the weakness of God is stronger than man's strength.~~

~~Adversity takes many forms. We choose whether we will become discouraged or not. Even before we left some situations arose, one of a serious nature, that could have caused us to back out, but we kept focused on our calling and prayed. The more we trusted God, the more assured we were that He wanted us to do this project.~~

~~We arrived in Belize and were immediately elated when the customs agent had us open every suitcase but the one that contained all the vitamins we had bought to keep us well. We hadn't intended to sell them, but they could have charged us a great deal of money in duty fees because we had no proof.~~

~~Our missionary friends were to meet us at the airport and we were going to drive around the city that day and the next to find a car. We stood on the sidewalk for about an hour and a half and finally realized they weren't coming. It was good that we'd been there before, otherwise, we may have been fearful. The taxis were coming sparsely so we realized we needed to hail one down quickly. We started walking toward the one that came. Then another taxi pulled up behind him and they started arguing. Finally, the second driver told us to come with him and the first man gave him no fight. After we were inside, the driver told us that the first man was not a licensed taxi and if he came near a checkpoint along the road (and there were many) he would dump us off, baggage and all, on the side of the road. I asked him what his name was and he said, 'Emmanuel'. That means 'God with us'. I thought, "Man this is gonna be good!"~~

~~We settled in at the hotel and called our friends. They had thought they were to be there the next day. What a way to start—up then down. But, once again, we chose to see what was allowed, as from God.~~

~~The next day our friends came up and we began the search for the 4 x 4 diesel car we thought we needed. Most of the cars had something major wrong with them or were too expensive. We had our prayer warriors praying specifically for this day because it was imperative that we get a car in the city. There were none where we were planning to live. Our friend's car's alternator went up and in the middle of everything we had to find parts. Nothing is simple in Belize. We had to spend an additional night in the motel but the next day we found our car—a 1989 Fifth Avenue we named Bessie. It wasn't even on the car lot because the dealer figured no one wanted it—it was an 8 cylinder and gas was over \$4.00 a gallon. The great thing about the car was that everything worked—even the power windows. The dealer's helpers often used it to take on dates—they all loved it and kept it in shape. With the price being much lower than we'd planned, we figured we could afford the gas. The extra day spent there allowed us to get a wire transfer along with the insurance and the tags. We wouldn't need to make the expensive and time-consuming trip back. Now, isn't God is the perfect orchestrator.~~

~~We had started our journey by seeing the Lord's hand and realizing how He had already planned for this up-and-down day so we could learn to count on His faithfulness and appreciate His blessings. This was just the beginning of more to come.~~

~~There would have been reasons to be concerned and reasons to fear, if we didn't have God to guide us. So I say to you...~~

Three days after we arrived in the sun-scorched land of Belize we finally made it to our destination. God had provided the home of two missionaries on furlough for us to use for our first three months. They needed someone to watch their house and we definitely needed a place to stay. In retrospect, we can't imagine what it would have been like to try to set up housekeeping from scratch.

It was late, so we sank into bed, and after a moment of silence and A big sigh of relief, we both said, "We're here". We'd been preparing for this day for six months. It was momentous, to say the least.

The utilities in the house were turned off and we had no food to speak of, so during our prayer the next morning we prayed that God would

help us get things hooked up and find some food. After prayer, Dale walked out on the veranda and heard a voice from below say, “Hi, I’m Germain from next door. I’ve come to help you get set up.” We were thrilled to receive our much needed answer so quickly. Germain spent the entire day with us, introduced us to all the people we’d need to interface with and showed us the food stores we should buy from - , and those we shouldn’t. What a God-send he was. After dinner, he and Dale sat on the front porch and Dale talked with him about the Lord.

The greatest benefit to being in need to that degree is that you get to see God in ways you normally don’t when you’re self-sufficient. He always finds creative ways to show how much He cares. And to think that He, the Creator of the universe, would even bother with us, insignificant creatures, is mind-boggling. What a merciful God He is.

Lamentations 3:22-23 says...

It is of the Lord’s mercies that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning – great is Thy faithfulness.

We ask for His mercies every morning. After all, if they are new every morning and we don’t ask, just think what we miss out on. The Bible says, ‘You have not because you ask not’.

King David wrote in Psalm 5:3...

In the morning, Oh Lord, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and wait in expectation.

In the story of Nehemiah we found that he solicited the help of many people to rebuild the Jerusalem wall. We had prayer partners working on their knees, and our missionary friends to consult, but we thought it would be just the two of us actually working on the station.

We expected to be inactive for a while as we waited for the radio license to be granted. But within three days our missionary friends received a call from a missionary farther south with whom they hadn't spoken in months. In the course of the conversation, they told him that we were in Belize to build a Christian radio station. He was overjoyed because he had a license that had taken him four years to get and he'd had it for a year. The Broadcasting authority was threatening to take it away from him because the station wasn't operating. In addition to the license, he'd been given a tower, transmitter, antenna, cable, studio equipment and 100 Christian music CD's. The only equipment he didn't have were computers – and guess who had that? We did!

He and his wife had been praying for someone to come to Belize and put everything together because they didn't have the expertise. —met Bob in 3 days—license

It was humbling ~~tHUMBLING too~~ see that God was going to use US as a small part of in the PIE He'E had already begun to buildmake. We learned that many people had been united in prayer, some as long as twelve years before, for a station to be built in their area. —

It would be GOD'S STATION – no one person could say they owned it.

I thought of how powerful unity is when I read about the Tower of Babel. The people were building a tower to reach to heaven – but for the wrong reason. They wanted to make a name for themselves. And God said of them...

What does this say about the power we can have as Believers, who are all baptized by one Spirit into one body – the body of Christ. We all need to take a lesson from this – forget our differences, forgive as we have been forgiven and receive the cleansing power from our mercy giver – Jesus Christ.

River of Life agreed — **high elevation** — **small, unfinished building**
— **Rev. Ernie** — **burdened for radio station for 10 years**

Isaiah 43:18 says...

..I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up, do you not see it?

— I am making a way in the desert; and streams in the wasteland.

The amazing thing about this verse, is this...

— It is indeed a new thing as there is no Christian radio in southern Belize.

— The ministry we worked with is called 'River of Life'.

— The building site is in the town called 'Dump'.

God knew we needed helpers to build — channeled 2 teams OUR WAY

Neh. 4:6 the people worked with all their heart — so did our teams!!!

— Loved about West Oaks (talked about Lord while they worked)

Tower base dug (2 Belizean boys) 9' deep 7' square — 75 bags cement

— Wrote PROVERBS 18:10 The Name of the Lord is a strong tower.

Volunteers unheard of in Belize (people need \$)

Raphael asked — 3 teens showed up followed by one kid's father.

As we were thanking Lord for them, Matt. 9:38 came to mind...

— Ask the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest field.

All who take part will reap harvest.

Named the station — HARVEST RADIO — food for life.
—— The meaning of the word ‘broadcasting’ is sowing seed.

March 31th (< month) tower was raised (85’) by the Lord & 15 men.
SANG ‘Praise God from whom all blessings flow.
Next day, while pouring cement for roof,
—— Dale & Rev Allan set up equipment/test broadcast for 2 hours!

Adversity — takes many forms — chose whether you’re discouraged
—— Donated equipment not working
—— shortage of workers, shortage of qualified workers (doors)
—— shortage of gas, concrete & things you wish you had HOME DEPOT
—— increase in prices (steel 75%) gas (\$4.06)
—— Dale sick — said he should see a specialist
—— problems at home (not willing to leave house/family not worthy)
—— someone wanted to buy our house
PRAYER made the difference — we KEPT OUR FOCUS

Neh. 4:14 Neh. said...Don’t be afraid of them (or fall prey to your adversaries).
Remember the Lord, who is great & awesome & fight for your brothers, your sons &
your daughters, your wives & your homes.

We needed to persevere for Belizeans to be able to hear the WOG.

Neh. worked quickly & diligently — long hours from dawn to dusk
Completed wall in 52 days — people feared Lord — knew it was Him
We did too, completed in 3 months — unheard of in Belize — over yr.
On June 8th we began official broadcasting!

LOVE TO LOOK IN RETROSPECT...

God worked timing out perfectly,
— We arrived 1 yr. from when license granted — almost taken away
— Frequencies stopped being approved
— Hurricane had sawed off trees near River of Life so hear in PG
— We stayed in a furnished house of missionaries on furlough
— Gayle/Dona at Cuxlin who rented furnished house in Toledo (save \$)
— River of Life was in process of buying land when we met them
— Building completed before the rainy season (would have delayed)
— God sent the 2 teams just when we needed them
— Gave us perfect weather — rained when needed didn’t when not

We sought/prayed for program manager w/same qualifications Neh.
— “Man of integrity and fears God more than most men do”
Wallace filled position (called 4 yrs. Ago) perfect for job.

~~In Neh. story people returned to Lord after Ezra read the Word of God.
Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of GOD!

——even to the dividing of soul/spirit, joints/marrow.~~
